

Charles & David Pettigrew Scholarship Fund Rules

The Charles & David Pettigrew Scholarship Fund will enable the children of Iron Workers Local #378 to compete for a one-time educational scholarship.

1. Scholarship eligibility will be determined as follows:
 - a.) Applicants must be a dependent of a member in good standing of Iron Workers Local #378. The parent or guardian of the applicant must have been a member in good standing of Iron Workers Local #378 for at least six (6) months preceding the date of application. Dependents of deceased member who were in good standing with Iron Workers Local #378 at the time of their death are eligible for scholarship consideration.
 - b.) Applicants must be either presently enrolled in their senior year of high school, at a college, university or accredited trade school, or scheduled to receive a General Education Diploma ("GED") by the end of spring semester 2017.
 - c.) Family members of officers and employees of Iron Workers Local #378 are not eligible for scholarships.
2. The scholarships will be paid directly to the scholarship recipients upon proof of full-time registration at either an accredited college or university or an accredited trade school. Scholarships may be used by the recipients to help off-set the cost of their education.
3. The scholarship winners must attend an accredited college, university or trade school of their choice and must be enrolled in a full-time program leading toward a degree. There are no restrictions on scholarship recipients' course of study.
4. Applicants shall submit a complete Scholarship Application within the specified deadline. The application must include an original essay. See the attached application for details.
5. The Charles & David Pettigrew Scholarship Fund will award one educational scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 funded by Brie Pettigrew, daughter of Charles Pettigrew. Recipients will be selected after careful consideration of submitted materials, including applications, essays and transcripts. In judging scholarship applications, the Scholarship Selection Committee shall also select a list of alternates. Such alternates shall be eligible in the order of their selection for scholarships in the event that one or more of the applicants should be unable to accept a scholarship award.
6. The Board of Trustees of the Scholarship Fund, at its discretion, may amend these rules at any time.
 - Dependents include unmarried natural, step, adopted and foster children who are younger than 19 years of age, who live with the active member and are solely dependent upon him/her for support. Dependent also include children who are 19 but less than 24 years of age, are full-time student with 12 or more credit hours, at an accredited educational institution and are solely dependent upon the active member for support.

Applications will be accepted beginning January 1, 2017. The deadline for application submittal is May 31, 2017.

INSTRUCTIONS:

All of the following items must be received by May 31, 2017.

1. APPLICATION – The application must be filled out and returned by the applicant. Applications will be accepted beginning on January 1, 2017.

2. TRANSCRIPT – The applicant must submit an **official certified transcript** indicating the last completed semester or quarter. The transcript is generally provided to the applicant in a sealed envelope by the accredited college or university or trade school and must be submitted with the Scholarship application.
